* SACQSP Professional Skills Modules will become available on 1 January 2013. Modules will be available from accredited providers and certain modules will also be available from or through the SACQSP.

Explanations:

1. APC = Assessment of Professional Competence (an oral interview/examination by professionals appointed by the SACQSP)
2. Accredited = assessed and approved by the SACQSP
3. NQF level 7 = 480 credits = Higher Education Band of the National Qualifications Framework = BSc Hons (QS)
4. Candidate = registered as Candidate QS with the SACQSP
5. In Training as Candidate = experience gained by Candidate QS as prescribed by SACQSP whilst employed, supervised and mentored by a PrQS
